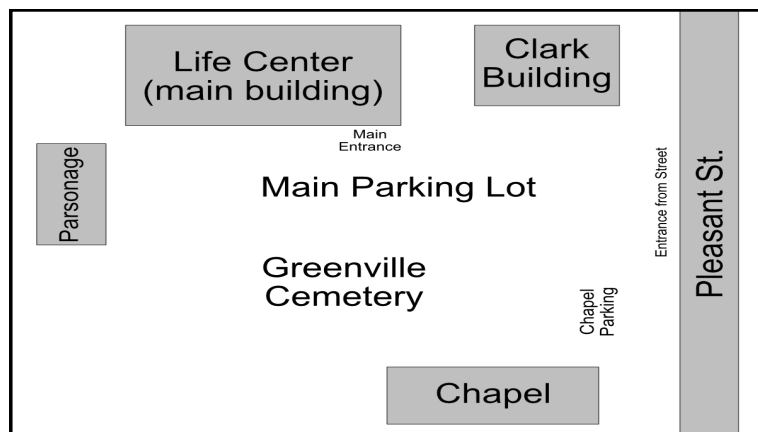
Today's Sermon
